You will tour an inn, blacksmith shop, school, church, general store and several homes reminiscent of an era gone by prior to 1900. There are steps involved to enter many of the buildings during this 1 to 1 ½ hour walking tour.

Following the tour we will drive into the town of Northville for a 12:30 p.m. lunch (on your own) at the Center Street Grill which is only five minutes away at 135 N. Center St, Northville 48167. After lunch, enjoy the wonderful original, boutique shops on E. Main and Hutton Streets.
