The Scripps Mansion was built by Edmund William Scripps for his family in 1927. Scripps was the son of the founder of the Detroit News and WWJ Radio. He amassed an estate covering over 3,000 acres including the mansion which encompasses 28,000 square feet in 67 rooms, including 11 fireplaces.

Within the house are elaborate woodwork, metalwork and stone and painted finishes, as well as Pewabic ceramic tile and stained glass designed by the Detroit Stained Glass Works.

The house now serves as a Catholic Retreat for clergy.

Optional lunch follows at the C-Pub down the road in Canterbury Village, once part of the Scripps Estate.
