Guidelines for Approved Shared Interest Groups (SIGs)

1. A proposed SIG needs to be approved by the SIG Chairperson.
2. Participants must be SOAR members in good standing in order to join a SIG. A SOAR member in good standing is one who has attended classes during at least one of the two SOAR class terms in a year, or who has enrolled in one or both winter programs.
3. SIGs are required to keep records of attendance and a group roster and to submit them to the SIG Chairperson upon request.
4. A SIG may choose to limit the number of members due to space constraints, discussion opportunities or other preferences.
5. Visitors who wish to learn more about a specific SIG are most welcome to visit one time, with the permission of the SIG Coordinator.
6. SOAR requires that no professional or commercial soliciting for products or services takes place during meetings.
7. A SIG will not promote activities that attempt to influence legislation, elections, or voter registration drives.
8.
